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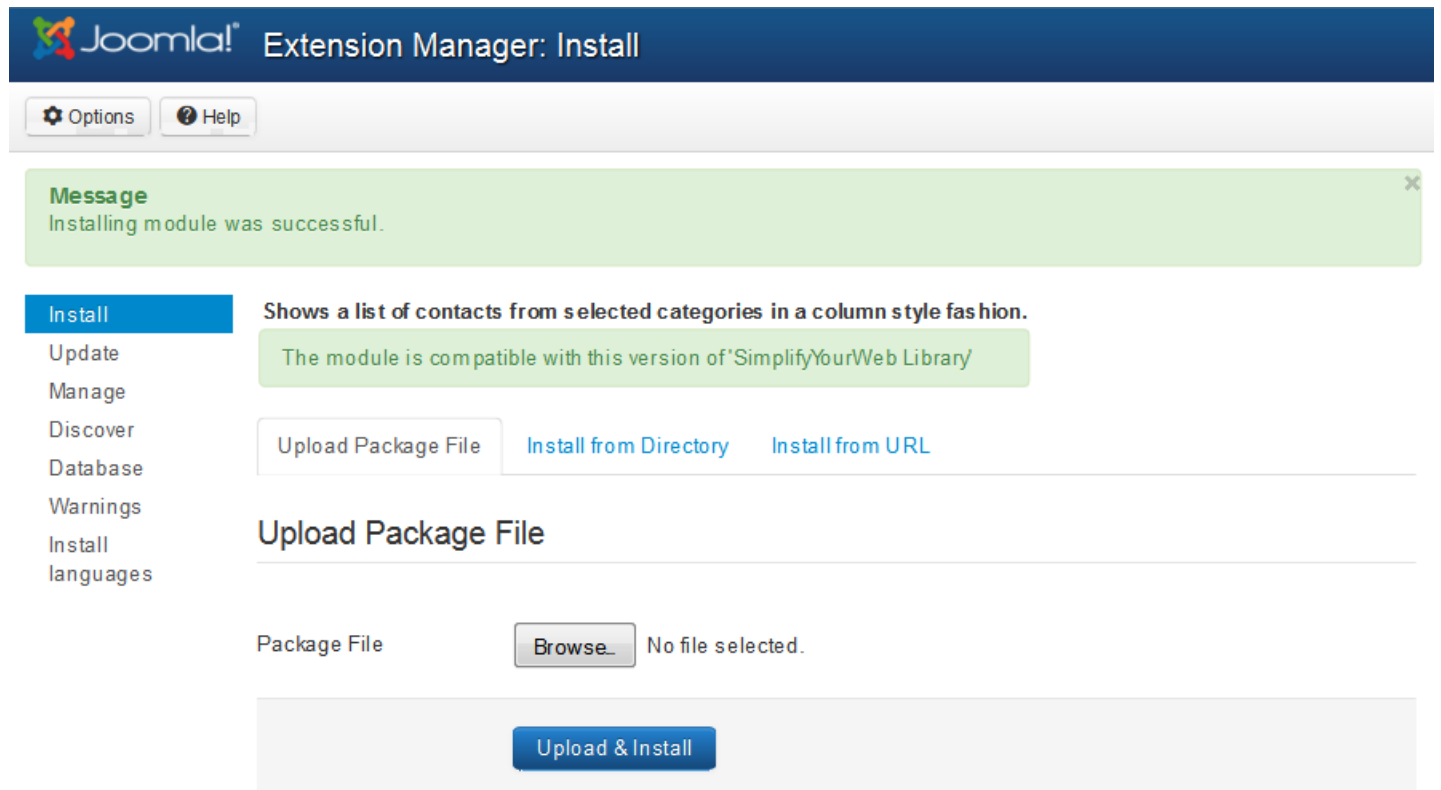
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Module Installation

Install the extension through the extension manager.

It will update itself if the module has been previously installed. In case of an update, make sure you read the changes that have been made and are aware of potential backward compatibility issues.

*Important note: the module requires you to previously install the external library **syw_lib**.*

The list of options

Here is the list of available options for the module.

Basic options

Option	Description
Selection from	The way the module must be used: to list contacts under specific categories , show a specific contact , related contacts or the linked user's contact information Note: to show related contacts, the shown contact on the page must have the same metakey(s) than other contacts (which then will show in the module's position)
Contact	When using the module to show a specific contact
Categories	When using the module to list contacts, all categories the contacts are listed from
Sub-categories	Include sub-categories or not
Max count	The number of contacts to show at most. Enter nothing to show all contacts
Picture alignment	Decide where the picture is located, left right, or alternate
Category order	When using multiple categories, the order of those categories
Order	Ordering of the contacts (by admin console order, contact's name field, contact's sort name fields or last/first name – considering the name is composed of 2 parts only)
Name format	The name format, considering the name is composed of 2 parts only. Otherwise use the way contacts are shown in the contact's name field
Default picture	The picture to use when a contact's picture is missing
Field 1	The fields to show. Use 'empty' to keep an empty space without data
Field 2

Address format	The format of the address
Keep space	Keep an empty space when data is missing
Link to contact	Link to the contact page or just a popup (when no form is present)
Popup width	The width of the popup
Popup height	The height of the popup
Link label	Add a link to the contact page/popup. Otherwise, the contact's name is used as a link when a link to the contact is selected

For the contacts to show properly, you need to have a menu item where your contacts would show. Create a menu item that will show the category (or all the categories if your contacts are from several categories). You probably don't want this menu item in your menu but it needs to exist in order for the contacts to load in a page fit for them.

Add `.item-xxx {display:none}` to your template stylesheet (xxx is the menu item ID for the menu item created) or create a menu for all hidden menu items but do not add it to the front end of the site.

Note: use the same resolution if you get a 500 error code. The contact links are not properly set in Joomla when SEF is set to 'ON' and the menu item is missing.
